Report on Grants and IT Donations (2016)

The EIB Institute aims at promoting local philanthropy by channelling support, mainly through grants for eligible initiatives or donations of IT equipment that is no longer used by the EIB Group, to non-profit organisations, local community centres or schools, registered in an EU Member State. In 2016, in the framework of the "Small Grants" Initiative, the Institute approved 23 grants, equating to a total of EUR 128 978, for the benefit of 23 different organisations. The table below provides further details on total requests:
