

EIB Institute Grants and IT Donations Report (2021)

Grants

As a key pillar of the EIB Group's community and citizenship engagement, the EIB Institute provides grants in response to humanitarian catastrophes and to support philanthropic social or sports events with relevant participation by EIB Group staff.

We made the following donations related to humanitarian catastrophes (details on pages 2 to 4):

Further, as part of its staff engagement, in 2021 the Institute provided a grant of €4 000 to Fondation Cancer Luxembourg for Relais pour la vie (a sporting event in Luxembourg), and another grant of €4 000 to the European Chess Association to run an educational chess training course for juniors and kids in Europe.

IT donations

The EIB Institute also aims to promote local philanthropy by channelling support through donations of IT equipment no longer used by the EIB Group to not-for-profit organisations, local community centres and schools registered in an EU Member State.

In 2021, the Institute donated **1 745** desktops, laptops, printers and other IT equipment to **105** schools and not-for-profit organisations (see pages 5 to 8 for details):

1. Beneficiaries of grants for humanitarian catastrophes in 2021

1.1 Croatia earthquake

€255 345 (including the voluntary contributions of the EIB Group staff) was donated to the government of Croatia (through the Ministry of Finance) to support the procurement of 30 container houses, which secured temporary housing for 78 people.

1.2 India COVID pandemic support

€45 000 was donated to Malteser International to help address the COVID-19 pandemic wave in India, focusing on the financing of disease prevention and healthcare support activities in Rajasthan.

€150 000 was donated to UNICEF Luxembourg to increase access to life-saving oxygen in priority states (via the purchase of one or more oxygen generation plants) and to boost RT-PCR (reverse transcription polymerase chain reaction) testing for rapid diagnosis and treatment.

€55 000 was donated to the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies for the implementation of measures for the prevention of infections, improving treatment and healthcare infrastructure, and for the fight against vaccine misinformation.

1.3 **Drought and famine in Madagascar**

€100 000 was donated to Save the Children Spain help prevent famine and improve access to food for the most vulnerable households in the Ambovombe district.

€100 000 was donated to UNICEF Luxembourg to treat and prevent severe/acute malnutrition in children, in particular through the provision of ready-to-use therapeutic food.

€50 000 was donated to Deutsche Welthungerhilfe e.V. to ensure, in the Amboasary Atsimo District, that the most vulnerable and crisis-affected population have safe access to emergency food and non-food assistance, keeping them above the survival threshold, reducing negative coping mechanisms and further livelihood deterioration.

1.4 Flash floods in NW Europe

€175 000 was donated to Deutsches Rotes Kreuz (German Red Cross) to provide those affected with food, drinking water, emergency shelter and psychosocial support.

€175 000 was donated to the Belgian Red Cross to be used notably to support the 'Rehabilitation of school buildings and purchase of school equipment for children' project.



1.5 Tunisia COVID

€100 000 was donated to UNICEF Luxembourg to help alleviate the consequences of the COVID pandemic in Tunisia, focusing on the financing of the purchase of oxygen concentrators, masks and other necessary medical equipment.

€150 000 was donated to the International Federation of Red Cross and Red Crescent Societies for immediate support to tackle the pandemic, including access to life-saving oxygen and mobile teams supporting treatment of patients in rural areas.

1.6 **Earthquake and storm in Haiti**

€125 000 was donated to Save the Children Spain to support the victims of the earthquake and storm in Haiti, by ensuring access to high-quality, safe education for 1 350 children and 20 teachers within several municipalities of the Sud and Grand'Anse, as well as providing babies with emergency hygiene kits.

€125 000 was donated to Malteser International for the reconstruction and improvement of five schools in the earthquake-affected communities of L'Asile, Petit-Trou and Baradères in Nippes Department, Haiti.

2. Beneficiaries of decommissioned IT equipment in 2021

In total, 285 desktop PCs and 1 460 laptops were donated, corresponding to a total of 105 approved requests. The beneficiaries were located across 16 countries: Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Kenya, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia and Spain.

In 2021, the Institute continued its partnership with Close the Gap, which takes used IT equipment to African schools, helping young people in the countries concerned to improve their educational and economic prospects. The EIB has donated more than 4 500 pieces of IT equipment to the organisation since 2014.
